other part, witnesseth that the said William B. Be-
nson & Thornton Benson for the consideration of eighty
dollars to them in hand paid by the said Joab
Bruton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and the said William B. Benson & Thornton Benson
have granted bargained and sold unto the sd.
Joab Bruton part of a Tract of Land or meadow
C. Creek of Enore River originally granted unto
Nathaniel Perry by his Excellency William Moultrie
the fourth of July 1785. begining at a Stake near
the head of a branch on the old line running
thence N. 80. E. 7 chain to a post oak thence S 40 E 37
70 to a Spanish Oak thence S 10 W. 90. 10. to a post
oak thence S 60 W. 12. to a post oak thence with
said line to the Fox Branch thence with said
branch to the mouth of said branch (viz) to
the manroe creek thence up the meanders of said
creek to first line on said Creek from thence
with said line to the begining corner on said Stake
the number of acres we knowen the said William
B. Benson & Thornton Benson will warrant &
for ever defend the aforesaid mentioned land
unto the said Joab Bruton his heirs &c. free and
clear from us our heirs Executors & admrs & from
all and every person or persons, whomsoever laying
any just right or legal claim to the same in
writing whereof we have hereunto set our
hands & seals this 2^d day December 1802. Signed
