Know all men by these presents that  
I Samuel Towns of the District of Greenville in  
the State aforesaid have bargained sold and  
released unto Jeremiah Cleveland of said State  
& District for and in consideration of the  
sum of five hundred and fifty two dollars.  
to me in hand paid by the said Jeremiah  
Cleveland the receipt of which is here by  
acknowledged a certain tract or parcel of  
land situated in said District aforesaid on the  
head of a branch of Brushy Creek of Rudy  
River containing two hundred and six acres  
by computation be the same more or less ac-  
cording to the annexed plat beginning at a  
red oak on the North side of the main  
Road leading from Greenville Village to  
~~the first mentioned Road~~ running thence  
N. 87. E. 97 chs. & 25 links crapping the branch to  
a black oak thence S. 70. W. 15 chs. to a  
red oak thence N. 25. W. 82 chs. to a pine  
sapling at the edge of the Road thence N. 28.  
W. 10 chs. 75 links to a black oak in the  
fork of the Road thence N. 60. E. 30 chs.  
with Genl. John Blasingame line crapping  
the first mentioned Road to the beginning  
with the exception of all the ear and  
privilege of holding the same at all  
times to be reserved to the intire use of  
Vassey McBe Together with all and  
singular rights and appurtenances to the  
said premises belonging or in any wise  
appertaining To Have and to hold all  
and singular the premises before men-  
tioned unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland  
his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby
