seven hundred and eighty six situated, in the State of
South Carolina Greenville District on the Branches of
Monroe's fork of Enore River and runs as follows.
that is to say. beginning on a Post oak on the south west
of Perrys survey thence due west twenty five chains
Twenty links to a red oak thence north twenty degrees
East thirty five chains fifty links to a pine corner
near a branch thence on pines survey from sd
pine corner straight line to Sneddys red oak corner
thence by road thence to Tankersby line thence
with said line to a square with Perrys north west
post oak corner thence to D corner thence a straight
line to the Taylor branch about four chains below
the head thence down D branch to its Junction with
a big branch thence down the meanders of said bran-
ch to a large poplar thence to a small Hickory
in the lane thence with a line of fence that divides
Perrys survey and the same to Perrys original line thence
to the beginning corner containing as aforesaid three
Hundred acres more or less including thirty thirty two
Acres of land ~~more or less~~ more or less contained in the above
mentioned lines granted to John Arno Smith the second day
of December one thousand eight hundred and Eleven
and conveyed by sd John Arno Smith to Samuel Fair
the said thirty two acres being found to be vacant after
sd Smith had conveyed the above described three hun-
-dred acres of land to sd Fair the sd Henry R. Frost Doctor
which ought to have been mentioned before his
heirs and assigns. To have and to hold the land
and premises and I do warrant and defend the same
from my self my heirs Executors assigns and assigns
and from all and every other person or persons from
claiming or to claim any part or parcel thereof
For ever as witness my hand and seal this 28th
day of July 1823.
