Know all men by these presents that I William Morris of the State and District aforesaid, in Consideration of the sum of sixteen Hundred dollars to me paid by Tully Bolling of the said State and District aforesaid Have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Tully Bolling a Plantation and tract Granted to John Marten on the third day of September 1787 for 623 acres and including the plantation, who are the said William Morris, now lives with the Mills on P. Mountain Creek beginning on a Sweet gum 3x on a branch near P. William Morris; Still House thence running N 23 W 5.70. to a pine 3x. thence N 54. W. 18.70. to a Black Oak 3x (and) thence S 17. W. 51.80. to a Stake 3x thence S 35 East 16.50 to a Post oak 3x. thence N. 75. E. 8.50. to a pine 3x. thence S 74 E. 14.50. to a Stake 3x N 74 E. 42. to a Stake 3x on the north bank of Mountain Creek thence up the meanders of said Creek about 30 to a Hickory 3x on the North bank of said Creek thence N 40 W. 3. to a post Oak 3x thence S. 80 W. 6. to a red oak Bush 3x. thence N 10 W. 9.50. to an ash bush 3x. thence South 80. W 4.50. to a Stake 3x in the fork of said Creek and a branch thence up the meanders of said branch to the beginning - including three Hundred acres of Land be the same more or less Together with all and singular the Rights, mem- bers, Hereditaments and appurtenances and to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises here mentioned unto the said Tully Bolling, his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto.
