 unto the said bay W. Jackson, his heirs and assigns
 forever, and we do hereby bind our selves our heirs Executors
 and administrators, to warrant and for ever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said bay
 W. Jackson, his heirs and assigns against our selves and
 our heirs and against every other person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof in witness whereof we have hereunto set our
 hands and affixed our seals this thirteenth day of
 August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty and in the fourth year
 of American independency signed sealed and deliver-
 ed in the presence of us.
