whom it may concern that Neely McElveen the wife
of the within named William McElveen did this day ap-
pear before me and upon being privately and separately
examined by me did declare that she doth fully and
voluntarily and without any compulsion stand a fear
of any person or persons whomsoever renounce, release
and forever relinquish unto the within named both
Barrett and Joseph Barrett their heirs and assigns all
her interest and estate and also all her right and claim
of dower of in or to all and singular the premises within
mentioned and released. Given under my hand and
Seal this 6th of February 1823.

twenty five dollars to me in hand paid by Edward
Maddox both of us of the State & District aforesaid have
granted bargained & sold & released unto the said Edward
Maddox a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and
being in the State & dist aforesaid on the N side of Jameson's
Mill Creek and some on the S side of said Creek.
