

This Indenture made this 15 of September one thousand eight hundred and twenty two witness that I Thos. McBarrell of the State of South Carolina to wit and of Gunville have this day sold and delivered unto Samuel McBarrell certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the State & District aforesaid containing by Estimation five hundred acres for the same more or less for and in consideration of one thousand dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, bounded on all sides by land save but by Salmon Jackson Bill Tubbs & others on both sides of Beemonteers Creek beginning on a poplar the origin- al corner running thence N 75° 39' to a stake thence S 63° 10' W by marked trees to crossing the branch and a branch thence along the Road to a post oak corner thence on bent line to a white O. corner thence on sd. line to a conditional corner thence to a white O. corner on Tubbs corner near a branch thence down to branch to a gum corner thence to a persimmon thence to a hickory thence to a red Oak thence to a stake on the back line thence to a post oak thence to a crab apple tree thence to a red O. thence to a poplar thence to the beginning all of which lands I hereby alone and release
