State of South Carolina Greenville District Reuben McKinger one of the within subscribing witnesses this day personally came before me and made oath the holy Gospel of God and saith that was present and did see the within named Thomas McBarrell sign and as his act and deed deliver the within Instrument of writing to the within named Samuel McBarrell, for the use and purpose therein mentioned, and that Andrew Bridges together with the deponent subscribed their names as witnesses to the due execution of the same in the presence of each other Sworn to the 26th day of March 1823.

I know all men by these presents that John Bridwell of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina for an Consideration of the sum of three hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by David Glass of the State and district aforesaid have bargained sold granted and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said David Glass all that plantation tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on Lick Creek beginning where Black banner line crosses the western branch of Lick creek then down the meanders of the creek to where Black banner line crosses said creek then a long laid line to a pine corner then a straight line to the beginning and do hereby warrant and defend the said land and premises unto the said David Glass his heirs and assigns forever against my self and my heirs and against every other person having any lawful claim to the same In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the tenth of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two signed sealed and delivered in presence of
