I know all men by these presents that I Solomon Kemp, of the State and District aforesaid of the one part and Hubbard Kenne of the said State and district of the other part witness that said Solomon Kemp doth for the inconsideration of the sum of two hundred dollars in hand paid hath bargained and sold unto the Kenne a plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and thirty more or less lying and being in the district aforesaid on the waters of Orange River upon Kemp's Branch begining at a pine corner joining James Bradly's line thence to a black oak corner thence to Cain Black Branch thence down said branch to Henry Benson's line and said branch to be the line thence on Benson's line to a black oak corner and thence to a black oak corner thence to a Post oak corner and thence to a post oak corner running thence to a Stake Oak corner and from thence to the beginning corner, it being part of a tract originally granted part to Daniel Faust surveyed for Aaron Kemp the other part granted to Solomon Kemp together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances orchards Woods Waters and Watercourses to have and to hold the said tract of land above described unto him his heirs Exec Adm^{ts} and Ass^{ts} to and he the said Solomon Kemp doth for his self his heirs Exec Adm^{ts} and Ass^{ts} forever warrant and defend the said plantation or tract of land unto the said Hubbard Kenne his heirs Exec Adm^{ts} & Ass^{ts} forever from the claim or demand of any person or persons whatsoever touching or conveying the same In witness whereof he the said Solomon Kemp hath hereunto set his hand and seal this 11th day of November one thousand eight hundred and seven and in the thirty second year of American Independence signed in the presence of us James Bradly
