I know all men by these presents that I James Bradley  
of the State and district aforesaid of me am part and  
Hubbard Herns of the other witnesseth that the other said  
James Bradley for an consideration of the sum of fifty  
dollars to him in hand paid hath bargained and sold  
unto the said Hubbard Herns a plantation or tract of land  
containing fifty acres being in the District aforesaid lying  
branch the waters of Enoree River joining S. D. Brown, begin-  
ning at a pine running to a branch then up the branch  
to a maple thence to a white stake from thence to a dogwood  
bush corner thence down the old his beginning corner on a white  
oak together with all and singular the appurtenances here-  
-dictaments woods and waters unto the said Hubbard Herns his  
heirs executors and assigns he said James Bradley, doth for  
himself heirs executors and assigns forever warrant and defend the  
tract of Land above mentioned unto the said Hubbard  
Herns his heirs executors and assigns for ever the claim or  
demand of any person or persons whatsoever touching or  
concerning the same In witness whereof the said James Bradley  
hath hereunto set his hand and seal this fifteenth day of  
November one thousand eight hundred and nine and in  
the thirty eighth year of American Independence signed  
seal d. and delivered in presence of

Greenville District and made oath and saith that he was present  
and saw James Bradley sign seal and deliver this instrument

ed before me this the ninth day of June 1810.
