Now know all men by these presents that I the said Jesse Brewer in order to secure the payment of said note as well as in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid, have bargained sold & delivered, and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the said Henry Smith, one crop card black Horse, one saddle, one bridle, one feather bed and furniture, and two towels, 1 cupboard, two chest, one table, two bed studs. To have and to hold the said Horse saddle, Bridle, feather Bed & furniture, towels, cupboard, chest, table, and bed studs to him the said Henry Smith his heirs and assigns forever Provided nevertheless and it is expressly understood that if the said Jesse Brewer his heirs Executors or administrators shall and do do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the Henry Smith his heirs or assigns the said promissory note of fifty two dollars thirty seven $\frac{1}{2}$ cents on or by the first January next then the above mortgage or bill of sale to be void and of none effect, otherwise the said Henry Smith his heirs Exrs. He are hereby authorized to take immediate possession of said Horse, saddle, bridle, Bed and furniture, towels, cupboard, chest, table and bed studs and proceed to sell the same conformably to Law for the purpose of discharging said sum of fifty two dollars thirty seven $\frac{1}{2}$ cents returning the overplus if any unto the said Jesse Brewer As witness my hand and seal this 21th July 1823
