

District on Hoopers Creek waters of Saluda River Beginning at a hickory on
 on the west bank of the Creek thence running S 78 W 36 deg 50 links to a hickory
 on land granted Nicholas Darnol and Vacant land, thence S 29 W 27 deg
 to a Red Oak on land granted to W. G. Turner, thence S 1 E 15 deg to a Red oak
 on part of the same, thence S 57 E 13 deg 50 links to a Red oak on part of
 the same thence S 85 E 17 deg 50 links to a hickory on part of the same thence
 S 20 E 16 deg 50 links to a Stake on part of the same on the west bank
 of said Hoopers Creek thence up said Creek as it meanders to the
 begining it being part of a tract of land Surveyed for Joseph
 Bridges and Elapso by Bruneau & Brunar the 1st day of March 1786
 and granted them the 6th day of March 1786 by His Excellency William
 Moultrie Esqr Governor &c together with all and singular the Right,
 numbers hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises be
 leaving or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to
 Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 Said Thomas Harr his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby
 bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 Said Thomas Harr his heirs and assigns against me and my
 heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof and each and every other person or persons whomsoever
 witness my hand and seal this third day of June in the year of
 our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty two and in the Independence
 of the United States of America the forty sixth & forty seventh
