South Carolina. To all to whom these presents shall come I Asa W. Crowder Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid, send greeting; whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the district of Greenville tested the first monday after the fourth monday of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two at the Suit of John S. Gray to me directed commanding me that that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements, of John Vaughn to levy the sum of four hundred and seventy one dollars and ninety four Cents damages and cost. I have seized and taken of the land and tenements of the said John Vaughn all that certain piece parcel and tract of land, containing three hundred acres more or less situate and being in the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid on each side of Rocky Creek waters of Enoree River being part of two tracts of land originally granted to David Lewis and Nathaniel Walker, one hundred Acres of the Land now intended to be conveyed was conveyed by the said Lewis to Blagrove Glenn by deed bearing date 19<sup>th</sup> March 1810 which is recorded in book H. page 343 and two hundred acres conveyed by Mear Ham Herbin to the said Blagrove Glenn by deed bearing date the 15 March 1810 and is recorded in book H. page 348. and both of which tracts are conveyed by the said Blagrove Glenn Daniel McKee
