Know all men by these presents that whereas John Kemp deceased late  
of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina was in his lifetime  
and at the time of his death seized and possessed by fee simple of all  
that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres (more or  
less) situated in the said State and District lying on horse Creek waters of  
Pee Dee River beginning on a black 3x on said creek running thence S 60  
W 19.50 to a red oak 3x bounding on Benjamin Arnolds land thence  
N 30 W 35 Chains to a stake 3x bounding on David Chandler and Genl  
Pices Lands thence S 60 W 1.00 to a stake 3x thence N 30 W 10 to a stake  
3x thence N 60 E 1.00 to a Rock 3x thence N 30 W 19.00 to a red oak 3x  
thence N 60 E 10 to a stake 3x on said Creek bounding on John C. Sullivan  
Land thence down the mean der of the Creek to the beginning and where-  
-as J. Polly Camp the widow together with William Camp, Daniel  
Camp, Dapby Camp, Elizabeth Chandler, Polly Camp, fur and her  
-the Heirs, the children and heirs of the said John Camp deceased  
and entitled as his heirs by the laws of the said State to their respective  
portions or shares of said land and whereas it is inconvenient to  
make partition of the said tract of land among the representatives  
of the said John Kemp Now know ye that we Polly Camp the widow,  
William Camp Daniel Camp Dapby Camp, Elizabeth Chandler, Polly Camp,  
and her the Heirs in consideration of five hundred dollars to us paid by  
Joel Ester of the State and District ~~and State~~ aforesaid have granted, bar-  
gained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said Joel Ester all and singular the premises above  
mentioned together with all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Joel Ester his heirs Executors administrators to us warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joel Ester his  
heirs and assigns against our selves and our heirs and against every  
other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
part thereof Witness our hands and seals this twenty four day  
of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
