




Mriman Burns directed to all and singular the Sheriffs of said State which Execution was duly entered in the Sheriffs office of said District the 5 of December 1812. the said John Wood did enter upon & seize under the said execution a certain tract or parcel of land herein after more particularly described and after notice of the intended sale of said Land did on the seventh day of June 1813 openly publicly & fairly according to the custom of Vendees expose subject nevertheless to all legal incumbrances whatsoever the same to sale to the highest bidder at Greenville Court House in the district aforesaid and the said land being so exposed was sold off to the said Robert Gurr for the sum of one hundred and thirteen dollars. he being the highest & last bidder for the same Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said John Wood as Sheriff of the District aforesaid for & in consideration of the said sum of one hundred and thirteen dollars to him in hand paid by the said Robert Gurr the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold & by these presents do grant & bargain & sell unto the said Robert Gurr all that plantation or tract of land Containing three hundred & Sixty Acres more or less lying & being in the district aforesaid on the Waters of Enore River joining the Tract belonging to Varina & Burns at the Cross Roads & Known by the name of John Wheeler old place divided from said Wheeler to Mriman Burns. with all and singular the Rights members appertaining to the said premises belonging incident or in any wise appertaining and all the Rights title claim Just est or demand the said Burns had in said lands at the time of the sale to have and to hold the said Tract or parcels of land as above described unto the said Robert Gurr his heirs & assigns forever subject never the less as above mentioned In witness whereof of the said John Wood Sheriff aforesaid have here unto set my hand & seal this day and year first above written.
