I know all men by these presents that I George Hopkins of the State and district aforesaid in Consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me paid by Scipio Peden of the said State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Scipio Peden a tract of land lying in the State and district aforesaid on the waters of Rudy River it being part of a tract of land originally granted to John Buckham on beginning on a black oak 3x three running North 14.30 to a black oak 3x thence N.34 W. 47.40 to a hickory 3x thence west 10 to a chestnut 3x thence south 45 to a hickory bush 3x thence N.84 E. 12.70 to a Spanish oak 3x near the mouth of the Spring branch thence S.25 E. 4.70 to a stone in the field thence N.12 E. 4.50 to another stone in the field thence N.84 E. 25 to the beginning in building the house and plantation where the said George Hopkins now lives with one hundred and forty acres of land at the same more or less bounded on the east by Adam Sturis on the north by my John Choice & Bakers on the west by Scipio Peden and on the south by the Hennman Watchers Land together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Scipio Peden his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Scipio Peden his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whom so ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this fourteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two and in the forty sixth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
