sum of two hundred dollars Now know all men by these present
that I the said William Thomason in order to secure the payment
of said judgments with the cast and interest thereon have bargained
sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto
the said Charley Martin one stud horse about five years old 1½ hands
high one bay filly four feather beds and furniture seven head of
meat cattle six head of sheep eighteen head of hogs one cupboard
chest and table and three & one dutch oven one butter dish twelve
plates & two basins To have and to hold all and singular the a-
bove named property to her the said Charley Martin her heirs
and assigns forever Provided never the less and it is Expressly understood
that if the above named William Thomason pays or causes to be
paid unto the said Charley Martin the aforesaid sum of two hundred dollars
on or before the 7th day of April then the above mortgage or bill of sale to be
void and of none effect Other wise the said Charley Martin her heirs
heirs Exrs &c is hereby authorised to take immediate possession of said
property and proceed to sell the same Conformably to law for the purpose
