shall come, I Asa Whoroder of Greenville District, and State
aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas, by virtue of a writ of fieri
facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for
the Greenville District lasted the first monday after the fourth
Monday in March in the year of our Lord one thousand
