

South Carolina. To all to whom these presents shall come, I Asa W. Crowder Sheriff of Greenville District, and State aforesaid, send greeting. Whereas, by virtue of sundry writs of fieri facias, I sued out of the court of Common Pleas, held for the district of Greenville tenth the day of in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and at the suit of John V. Soddel, Jeremiah Cleveland, Samuel Earle, Peter Coulter and Archahab Fowler and Leonard Tenant to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements, of James McDaniels to levy the sum of two thousand two hundred and fifty dollars damages and cost. I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said James McDaniels all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, containing nine hundred and eighty acres more or less situate and lying in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid, begining at a black oak corner on the trail Road running thence S. 59 ch. 40. to a stake 3x. thence S. 34 ch. go left to a stake 3x. thence S. 70 E. 16 ch. to a stake corner, thence S. 55 W. 17 ch. thence S. 26 E. 32 ch. thence S. 64 W. 32 ch. thence N. 26 W. 32 ch. to a P. oak 3x. thence N. 70 W. 52 ch. along the Trail Road to a Red oak 3x. thence N. 11 E. 32 ch. to a hickory 3x. near Holly Spring thence down the Branch to a Cherry 3x. thence S. 37 W. 11 ch. to a B. oak 3x. thence N. 46 W. 26.50 ch. to a Beach 3x. thence N. 8 W. 10 ch. a crop the Grove Road to a mulberry 3x. at a branch thence up the branch to an ash 3x. thence S. 70 E. 33 ch. 50 links to a P. oak 3x. thence S. 60 E. 19 ch. across the Grove Road again to a stake on Paynes branch thence up Paynes Branch to an ash 3x. thence S. 61 E. 20.50 to a P. oak 3x. thence N. 13 E. 3. 83 hickay 3x. thence N. W. 34 ch. to a cherry 3x. thence N. 70 W. 8. 50 to a chestnut 3x. thence N. 20 E. 55 chains to a stake on the trail Road. thence down the Trail Road to the begining and whereas the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by virtue of said writ of fieri facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at Public Vendue, and purchased by Jeremiah Cleveland of the district of Greenville aforesaid for the sum of one thousand dollars being the highest sum that was bid therfor. Now know ye, that I Asa W. Crowder Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of one thousand dollars to me
