Right had of or and to the same; To Have and to hold the
 said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances
 unto the said William Bates his heirs and assigns forever, as fully
 and absolutely as I the said Asa W. Crowder might, could
 or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same, by virtue of
 the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of fieri facias or
