Know all men by these presents that Archabald Taylor of Greenville District & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the love good will and natural affection which I have and bear for and toward my daughter Margaret Cammel wife of William Cammel of the said district and State aforesaid and for the further consideration of One dollar to me paid by the said Margaret Cammel have given granted bargained & delivered and by these presents do give grant bargain and deliver unto the said Margaret Cammel and to the heirs of her body two certain negro girls named Dasha & Hannah (one six years and the other four years old) with their future increase unto the said Margaret Cammel and the heirs of her body henceforth forever to be divided by sale or otherwise at the death of her present husband William Cammel equally between her and her said heirs and in case she should die first then to be divided as aforesaid among her said heirs hereby warranting and defending the said negro girls and their future increase unto the said Margaret Cammel her heirs aforesaid. Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 18 day of October 1823.
