George Davis Rents of John H. Harrison the place <sup>157</sup> in Green-  
 -ville District whereon Alexander Stul lived for one year, say till  
 the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1824 and obliges himself to put the plan-  
 -tation under a good fence and make no unnecessary waste of  
 timber nor suffer other persons to trespass on the premises and  
 John Harrison is to let the said Davis have sixty Bushels of corn as  
 it may be wanted for the use of said place, three Hogs for pork  
 & one very large blind mare. and the said Davis obliges him-  
 -self to pay at the end of the year sixty five bushels of good  
 sound dry Corn delivered on the place and sixty five dollars in  
 Cash or produce at cash price. no articles shall be taken from  
 the place till this agreement is fully complied with nor the right  
 of property changed but to be from this time subject to the  
 laws relative rent. Witness my hand this 30<sup>th</sup> December 1823

 6. 50 L. to a white oak thence S. 80. W. 10. 6. 50 L. to a poplar thence  
 S. 55 W. 31 6. 50 L. to a white oak thence S. 48. 6. 36. 00 to the begin-  
 -ing corner containing one hundred and twenty seven and  
 five yards square Excepted a round sd Stephens deceased wifes  
 grave the same being granted to Hugh Nelson by His Excellen-  
 -cy John Jay Pinckney bearing date may the second day one  
 thousand seven hundred and ninety. Together with all and
