Alden to David Henning and by David Henning to Jeremiah Cleveland and by the said Cleveland to me Together with all and singular the Rights manors hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident therunto To have and to Hold unto and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said John H. Goodlett his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the before mentioned premises unto the said J. H. Goodlett his heirs and assigns a gainst myself my Heirs and assigns and a gainst every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully Claiming or to Claim the Same or any part thereof Witness my hand and Seal the the eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty four and in the 48 year of the American Independence Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of
