 square containing one hundred feet front on Jail Street
 by one hundred and seventy six and a fourth feet deep
Beginning at a Stake on Jail Street thence with said
 South 15 degrees west one hundred feet to a Stake then
 North seventy four degrees West one hundred and seventy
 six & one fourth feet to a Stake then North sixteen
 degrees East 100 feet to a Stake thence $10.74 \cdot 2.176\frac{1}{4}$ feet
 to the beginning ⁰ together with all and singular the
 Rights members habitaments and appurtenances to the said
 Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To Have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-
 tioned unto the said Benjamin Dunham his heirs and assigns
 forever And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs executors and
 Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and
 singular the said premises unto the said Benjamin Dunham
 his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against
 all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully
 claiming to claim the same or any part thereof
