Carreth all that certain piece Parcel and tract of land, containing five hundred acres situate and being in the district of Greenville in the said state on the waters of bush Creek of Reedy River bounded by lines running south East by John Woodfield, and ^{John} Mackerns Land, S.W. by John Rogers, and Jeremiah Chandler, N.E. by John Safety N. by Tarrows, as will more fully Represents by the plat annexed to the grant, originally granted to Solomon Murphy by Jph Carter bearing date the 20 October 1794 deputy survey in the said district before said and where as the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me under virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by John Charles of the district of Greenville of the state aforesaid for the sum of twenty six Dollars, being the highest sum that was bidden therefor, now knowye That I, Asa W. Crowder Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and By virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and for and In consideration of the said sum of twenty six dollars to me in hand Paid, or secured to be paid by the said John Charles the receipt and payments whereof, I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said John Charles heir and assigns for ever the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right title and Interest, which the said A. Carreth of right had of in and to the same, to have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract
