 Avery thence N. 65. W. 8. 80 to a stake corner & thence N. 5 E. 49' to
 a pine & Red Oak corner & thence land of Franky Chandler
 & heirs thence N. 85. W. 10. 50 to a red Oak corner & thence N. 21 W. 9. 50.
 to a Red Oak bush & thence S. 63 E. 30 to the begining corner
 Together with all and singular the Right, members, Appurte-
 nments & appurtenances, to the said premises, belonging or in
 any wise appertaining or incident to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto him
 the said Heulet Sullivan his heirs & assigns forever and
 I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators
 to warrant & forever all and singular the said premises
 unto the said Heulet Sullivan his heirs and assigns
 & against myself my heirs & against every person whom
 I may lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
 part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and seal this 23 Febyary one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty two & in the forty sixth year
