Recorded in Grant Book F. No. page 308 beginning on a Post Oak 3x near the road running thence S. 88 W. 17. to a Stake 3x thence S. 62 E. 7. to a crooked Spanish Oak 3x thence N. 89 E. 21. across the creek to a dogwood 3x thence N. 15 E. 5. 33. to a B. thence N. 33 E. 25. 25. to a post Oak 3x thence across the same creek 180 E. 31. 50 to a Spanish Oak 3x near the Road on Nathan Burys land thence a long a Road S. 25 W. 16. to the beginning binding N. W. on the S. Sullivan's land N. E. on Stephen Ford's Land N. E. on Micajah Burys Land & on Nathan Burys Land and S. W. Thomas Davin's land including the house and plantation Britton Brewer now lives containing eighty Acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Hewlet Sullivan Jr his heirs and assigns for ever
