 wheels, four pots, one oven, four pails, 6 Peter plates, two plows, 1 pair
 gears, two axes, one mattock, three chests & 2 dog chairs. So have and to
 hold the said mare & colts, cattle, hogs, geese, corn, fodder, beds & furniture
 wheels, pots, oven, pails, plates, plows, gears, axes, mattock, chests, chairs,
