 Men by these presents that I Thomas Atton of the state and
 District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one
 hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Johnson of
 the said District the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged I have
 granted bargained sold and Delivered and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James
 Johnson certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in
 Greenville District and State aforesaid on Mill Creek beginning
 upon a red oak corner from thence S. 45 W. 23 Chains to a pop-
 lar thence N. 45 E. 65 chains 21 links to a stake thence S. 45 E. 16 chains 32
 Links to a stake thence S. 40 W. 60 chains to the beginning corner being by
 Estimation, one hundred and fifty acres more or less, the same being
 granted unto Isaac Mayfield by patent bearing date the 29th
 Day of March 1789 and by the S^d Isaac Mayfield conveying to John
 Young together with all and singular the plantation, improve-
 ments rights members hereditaments, appurtenances, belonging or
 in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singul-
 ar the said Lands & premises before mentioned in to the said
 James Johnson his heirs and assigns for ever and do warrant
 And hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators
 to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the S^d lands
 Premises unto the S^d James Johnson his heirs and assigns and
 against me my self my heirs and against all other persons
 or persons whomsoever lawfully claim or to claim the same
 or any part thereof as witness my hand and seal this the 17th
 February 1824 Attest and delivered in presence of
 Albert W^m Thurston W^m Thurston Jun^r Thomas Atton
