South Carolina know all men by these presents that Archibald Taylor of Greenville District in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, to me in hand paid, by my son Archibald Taylor Jun^r. the Receipt whereof I do here by acknowledge have granted bargained sold Released conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell release convey and confirm unto the said Archibald Taylor Jun^r. his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land, containing two hundred and Eighty acres, both the same more or less situate in Greenville District on Both sides of Musk Creek and on the branches thereof being part a tract of five hundred acres of land granted to John Nicoll by a grant bearing date the sixteenth day of July one seven hundred and Eighty four and by said John Nicoll conveyed to my self and runs as follows that is to say Beginning on a black oak on the north side of Musk Creek thence due west twelve Chains to a stake thence south Eighteen degrees west Eight Chains to a sapling oak thence south Eighty degrees west nineteen Chains and fifty Links to a stake at the mouth of a large Ditch, thence up said Ditch five Chains to a stake thence north sixty on degrees west seventeen Chains to a stake on a new ditch thence south forty seven degrees west six Chains to the mouth of a ditch thence south twenty seven degrees west up said Ditch sixteen Chains and fifty Links to a stake thence up the East of swamp to white oak on Flora Bowells line thence south forty seven degrees East to a stake and Dinters thence north Eighty one degrees East Twenty seven Chains to a small white oak in a branch thence up said Branch Ten Chains and fifty Links to a stake on Nicoll's south line thence East with said line to Nicoll's corner thence to the Beginning containing Two hundred and Eighty acres aforesaid, Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said par-
