 ich lines as described includes the above one hundred & forty acres conveyed  
 together with all and singular the hereditaments or appurtenances

 defend the aforesaid tract of land unto the said Sunford Hudson  
 his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> adm<sup>ors</sup> and assigns against my self my heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> and  
 Adm<sup>ors</sup> and against all persons or persons whom ever lawfully claim-  
 ing or to claim the same wit my hand and seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day  
 1824 and in the forty eight year of the Independency of the united states  
 of America witness I

 on the Branches of No saluda and No. pacotet Begining on Hickory  
 Bounded by golwell <sup>land</sup> whare said Pitman corner, thence S. 47. W. 13  
 To white oak stump x thence N. 16. 50 to a spanish o. 3x on on  
 Phillips line thence N. 70 W. 70. 00 to a Hickory 3x on Wheters  
 corner thence to a stake thence N. 80 S. 20 to a stake thence
