

Two, (A. 2. 2) containing one hundred and forty feet front on main street and one hundred and seventeen and on half feet on the cross street below Mr. Wickliffe, Beginning at a Stake corner on the west side of main street running thence North 74 1/2 degrees West 117 1/2 feet to a Stake thence South 15 1/2 degrees West, 140 feet to a Stake, thence South 74 1/2 degrees East one hundred and seventeen and on half feet to a stake on the side of main street, thence North fifteen & on half degrees East one hundred and forty feet along main street to the beginning, containing half an acre, be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appertinances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas G. Walker his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self, my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Doct. - Thomas G. Walker, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs And against any person claiming by through or under me, witness My hand and Seal this seventeenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and sixteen and in the forty first of The American Independence signed sealed and delivered in the presence of Wm Holcomb, William Toney & Geo. Earle sign seal and acknowledge the within deed of conveyance to Dr Thomas G. The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I, John Chandler of Greenville District in the state aforesaid in consideration of eight hundred and fifty one dollars to me paid by John Blackstock of Laurens District, and state aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell, and Release unto the said John Blackstock, all that plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred and seventy six acres, more or less, situated in the district of Greenville lying on the Branches of Horse creek Waters ofuddy River beginning on a Spanish oak 3x running thence N. 30 W. 54 chains to a Dogwood, 3x bounding on Samuel and John Marens.
