E 50 Chains to a sawer wood 3x a bought one Chain North of the Spring that John M. Craft now uses thence N 60. W. 40 ch to a Chestnut 3x thence S 80 E 38. to a Post Oak 3x thence S 22. W 58 Ch. To a Hickory a few chains East ward below M. Lockers Spring thence along The original line to where it crosses Pyles Branch thence down said Branch with its various meanders to the Beginning including of Three Hundred & forty five acres. Be the same more or less together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to The said premises belonging or in any wise
