ing on a Post oak 3x a conditional corner of Aquila Longs Running
Thence N. W. to a Hickory 3x thence N. E. on an old Boundary line betwixt.
S. Thos. Long and Samuel Moore, to a black oak 3x thence on a condition
al line to a post oak 3x on the old original line Betwixt S. Thos. Long
And Ceborne thence E. on the old line Betwixt S. Thos. Long and Ceborne to the
conditional corner of Aquila Longs on a Post oak thence S. W. on a cond
itional line maid by P. Aquila Long to the beginning containing fifty
Acres more or less together with all and singular the rights and
and appurtenances therunto belonging, and I do bind my self my
Heirs Executors and Administrators and assigns to warrant and ver
Defend the above tract of land from the just claim of any person
or persons what soever where unto I have set my hand and seal this
10th day of July 1824, signed sealed and delivered in the presence
of Brasher Henderson Jordan J. Moore & Thomas Long ^{Seal}
