or less beginning as follows on a black oak corner thence N 40 E 48 to  
a State corner thence N 56. W 51 to a Post oak corner thence S 40.  
W 42. 150 to a maple stump corner thence S 50. E 50. 85 to the begin-  
ing including one hundred and Eighty seven acres of Land  
more or less Together with all and singular the Rights and all that  
appertain to the sd Land and premises before mentioned to the sd.  
Abraham Cox his heirs and assigns forever, and I do here by bind-  
my self my heirs and assigns to warrant and for ever defend  
all and singular, the sd. premises to the sd. Abraham Cox, against  
my self my heirs and assigns and against all other persons  
claiming the same or any part thereof whereunto I the sd.  
Jacob Black do here unto set my hand this 8<sup>th</sup> day of Septem-  
ber Eighteen hundred and twenty four signed and delivred
