a Stake corner thence a State line a conditional line to the Beginning

Including one hundred acres of Land more or less Together with
all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertain-
-ences to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises
Before mentioned unto the sd. Abraham Cox, his heirs and assigns for
-ever, and we do here by bind our selves, our heirs Executors and Admin-
-istrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the

sd. one hundred acres of Land more or less, with the premises unto
The sd. Abraham Cox Jur. his heirs and assigns against our selves
our heirs, and assigns and all and Every other person or person
Whatsoever In witness whereof we do here unto set our hands
and seals this thirteenth day of February one thousand Eight
Hundred and nine sign sealed and delivered in the presence of
