Dep't Surveyor containing by estimation forty five acres, be the same more or less together with all the Rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Magness his heirs and assigns against myself and my Heirs and against Every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness where of I have here unto set my hand and seal this Eight day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and twenty three in presents of Green P.
