 Tract of land unto Samuel Carter of the District and State of S.C. and granted
 to Richard Madden and deeded to Jonathan Dewest and Recently conveyed
 to John Rice lying on the main road leading from Greenville Court house
 to Augusta for and in consideration of two hundred and twenty five dollars
 in two annual payments the first of one hundred dollars due the twenty fifth
 of December 1825 and the other one hundred and twenty five due
 the 25th of December 1826 and the receipt of his the S.C. Carter obligations acknowledge
 and the said John Rice here bind myself when the money is paid by S.C. Carter
 or his agent to make a good and sufficient title to the said Land Given from under
 my hand this the twenty seventh of March in year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and twenty five signed and delivered in the presence of
 Alex^r H. Haliday Samuel Rice John Rice (Seal)

South Carolina Greenville District personally came Alexander H. Haliday before
 me and made oath that he saw John Rice sign seal and acknowledge the
 within deed of conveyance to Samuel C. Carter for the uses and purposes therein
