 Sheriff of Greenville District and State of aforesaid send
 Greeting Whereas by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issued out of the
 Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville listed the
 nineteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and twenty four at the suit of Arthur Barrett Administrator to me
 Directed Commanding me that of the Goods and chattels lands ^{and} tenements
 of John A. Butler to levy the sum of One hundred and seven dollars
 Eleven cents damages and costs I have seized and taken of the Lands
 and tenements of the said John A. Butler all that certain piece parcel
 and tract of Land containing one hundred & seven acres more or
 Less in two deeds situate and being in the District of Greenville and
 State of aforesaid beginning on a stake on the north side of middle
 Tyger on the bank of said River running thence 29 E 8 chains to a ^{wood}
 then north 28 W 40 to a red stake thence South 82 W 1 chain to a
 Post stake thence N. W. 27 chains to a stake on the bank of the River
 thence down the several meanders of the said River to the beginning
 containing fifty seven acres also fifty acres more or less beginning
 at a white stake on the south west side of middle Tyger River
 On George Millers corner thence with his line S 29 W 11 chains to a black
 Oak thence North 82 W 31 chains 50 links to three Chestnuts John Henson
 Corner thence N. E. 24 chs to the river thence down the meanders thence
 to the beginning Grant bearing date 21st January 1785 unto Allen Gower
 and whereas the said premises with their appertinances since the seizure by
 me made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned have been
 Exposed to sale at public ^{the sum of} and purchased by John Henson of the District
 and State of aforesaid for one hundred & sixty dollars being the highest sum that
 was bidden therefore now know ye that I Nimrod Underwood Sheriff of aforesaid by
 virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as
 aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and
 for and in consideration of the said sum of one hundred and sixty dollars
 to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said John Henson the
 Receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted
