C. Williams the Land is laid out to the said Benjamin Dunn as follows Bounded N. E. by Land Originally Granted to Hugh Roark until it intersects with the sd. Armstrongs line thence N. E. with said line to the said Reedy River thence up the meanders of sd. River to a conditional corner willow oak corner a grad on in the presence of John Smith and Isaac Hide thence a long a conditional line South Westward to a stake corner in a post oak Stamp thence N. Westward a long a conditional line until it intersects with the course of a line known by the name of Lendamans Old line to a corner thence South Westward to the original Stake corner of sd. Lendamans line thence with said line 40.23 to a stake corner on John Pyles line thence S. E. 30° 43 to a stake corner thence N.
