Tunc of the State and District aforesaid of the one part and Thomas Edwards
of the other part Witnesseth that the aforesaid Samuel Tunc for an in-
satisfaction of the sum of one hundred Dollars to him in hand paid hath bargained
and sold unto Thomas Edwards a plantation or tract of containing one
Hundred and Seventeen acres of Land in the District aforesaid on both sides
of Hemp branch of waters of Enoree River beginning at a white oak
then on Irish Conners line West to red oak then W. E. a cross Hemp
Branch at mouth of a little Branch and thence up the East side of the
Branch to a small post oak then East to a post oak on Carnegys
thence to the Beginning corner on white oak together with all
& woods and waters appertaining to the sd Thomas Edwards his heirs
assigns he the sd Samuel Tunc doth for him self heirs and assigns
and assigns for ever warrant and defend the sd tract of land above
mentioned unto the sd Thomas Edwards his heirs Executors administrators
~~for ever~~ and assigns for ever the claim or demand of any person person
Whatsoever touching or claiming the same in witness whereof the said Samuel Tunc
has unto set his hand and seal this fourth day of October one thousand eight hundred
and Eleven and in the thirtieth Eight of American Independance signed
and delivered in presence of Absalom Carnegys Hubbard Kearns & Samuel Tunc
