

State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that Miles Jennings of the aforesaid State & District do bargain sell & deliver unto Jacob Linderman of the aforesaid State & District a certain tract of Land whereon I now live lying on the west side of Reddy River beginning on a Pine & thence N 20 E 39 to a red Oak thence S 50 E 16 to a poplar & on Spring Branch thence down said Branch to the Creek thence down said Creek to a poplar & on Nathan Berrys line thence S 32 W 12 to a post oak bush thence S 39 W 40 to a red oak & thence N 55 W 17 to the beginning the same containing one hundred acres of land more or less all & singular the premises above mentioned & appertanances to the same to have & to hold unto the said Jacob Linderman his heirs & assigns for ever & the said Miles Jennings do bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & for ever defend the rights & premises above mentioned unto the said Jacob Linderman his heirs & assigns from me my heirs & assigns & every other person or persons claiming the same or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this fourth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty six A.D. 1826

State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Wheaton Merritt of the District of Greenville and State of aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and seventy Dollars to me in hand paid by Alfred Hightower of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid the receipt whereof is here by fully acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alfred Hightower a certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation thirty acres more or less situate lying and being in the District of Greenville in the State of aforesaid on the west side of the North fork of Saluda River adjoining the said Alfred Hightowers Land it being the upper part of a tract of land Originally granted to John Makin and hath such bounds as follows viz Beginning on the old line on the west bank of the river thence down the river to the mouth of the Spring branch which is a conditional line thence up the said Branch opposit to a steep point of a ridge thence a strait line from the branch to a marked dogwood and a marked Spanish to a marked Beech on the point of the ridge thence along the said ridge in a western direction to a marked black Gum the said line being conditional lines between the said Merritt and the said Hightower thence from the Black Gum by a marked white oak a strait line to the old original line thence on the old line N 60 E to a pine corner thence on the old line to the beginning together with all and singular the rights and members hereditament and appertanances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
