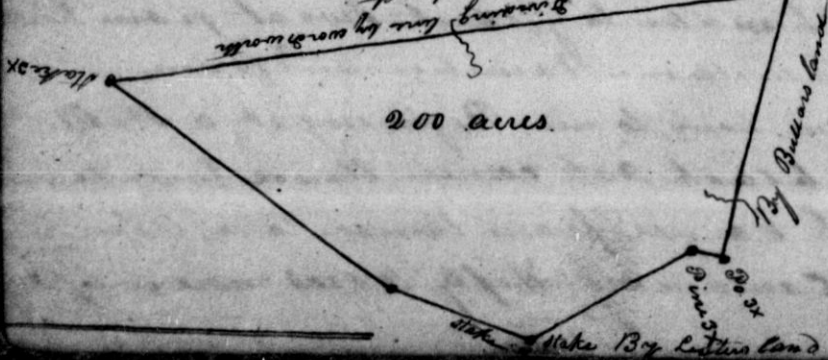

South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Wilson of Greenville District and State aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Thaxton of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and release and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said James Thaxton a plantation or tract of Land it being a part of a tract that was originally granted to Bath Birdsong and conveyed through different hands down to the said John Wilson the Land to be conveyed is lying and being situated in the District and State aforesaid on the waters of Gilders Creek of Enoree River beginning on Stake thence N 63 W. 41 to Stake on Lesters line thence S 70 W to Stake thence S 45 W. 23.50 to pine 3+ on the W 2.57 to Post 3+ then S. 34.22 to post oak 3+ then N. 69 E by dividing line between Wardsworth and him self to the beginning including two hundred acres together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appertanances unto the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Thaxton and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Thaxton his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 2nd day of March 1807 Just Amb. Blackburn Thomas R. Crawford & John Wilson Seal
