South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these Presents that I Samuel Tarrant of the State of South Carolina and district of Greenville in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear to my son John Tarrant of the State and district above mentioned and for and towards the better support and maintenance of him after my decease & for divers other good causes and considerations me thereunto especially moving, have given granted and sold, and by these Presents do give, Grant and sell unto the said John Tarrant all my and singular my goods and Chattels whatsoever & wheresoever or of what Nature sort or kind forever, To Have and to hold the said goods and Chattels hereby granted bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof his Executors Administrators and assigns, as his and their own proper chattels and effects from henceforth forever. — Provided always and these presents are upon the special trust and confidence and upon this express condition, that the said John Tarrant his Executors administrators & assigns shall and do permit and suffer me the S<sup>r</sup> Samuel Tarrant with my family, to use keep and enjoy during my natural life without paying or yielding any thing for the same in respect thereof and not otherwise. and from and after my decease the said John Tarrant his Executors administrators and assigns shall or lawfully may have, hold and enjoy the same and every part and parcel thereof & dispose thereof and convert the same to his or their own proper use and behoof as he or they shall think fit. The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Ward<sup>106</sup> M<sup>106</sup> Bee of Lincoln County in the State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Moses Jones of Greenville district in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and do by these presents, bargain sell and release unto the said Moses Jones a certain Lot of Land in the North West Square of the Village of Greenville, known and distinguished in M<sup>106</sup> Bee's plan of said Village by its No. being No. 41. in said Square. Beginning at a Stake on David Carrier's Lot and running thence N. 16. E. 150 feet along a Street that is 40 feet wide to a Stake near the Buncombe road, thence N. 74. W. 200 feet to a Stake, thence S. 16. West 150 feet to a Stake on a corner of Lot No. 40 sold to David Carrier as aforesaid, thence South 74 East 200 feet to the beginning which said Lot the Buncombe road runs through
