Have granted, bargained, sold, released, and by these Presents do Grant bargain sell and release, unto the said Commissioners of the Poor and their Successors in Office a certain Tract or plantation of Land, situate in the District and State aforesaid on branches of Brush Creek Water of Ruddy River, beginning on a Black oak, then No. 27. E. 39. ch. to a Post oak, thence N. 42. E. 64. ch. to a Hickory, thence S. 89. W. 80. 5. ch. to a Black oak, thence S. 11. E. 48. 5. ch. to a post oak thence S. 42. E. 53. ch. to the beginning containing by resurvey Five hundred and fourteen acres originally granted to Solomon Murphy. Together with all and singular the rights manors hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incidental or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Commissioners of the Poor for Greenville and their assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators Heirs and assigns forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Commissioners of the Poor for Greenville District and their assigns against myself and my heirs Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. The State of South Carolina Greenville Dis^t, This Indenture made and confessed the ninth day of October and the Year One thousand Eight hundred and Nine between John White of the one part and Aquilla Bradley of the other part witnesseth that the said John White hath granted, bargained and sold unto the s^d Aquilla Bradley of the same State and district his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of Land situated, lying and being in the district of Greenville on the waters of Ruddy River & Enore River, containing One hundred and one acres it being more or less and bounded as follows viz Beginning on a Spanish oak the original Corner, thence South 30 de East running the original line to a Stake, thence a conditional line Eastward to a Stake, on the original line, thence the said or line, No. 20. D. E. to a Stake on the s^d line, thence to the original line, thence to the beginning. — it being part of a Tract of Land granted unto Joseph Nations, the sixth of February 1786. To have and to hold the above s^d Land and premises with all and singular privilege and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the s^d Aquilla Bradley his heirs and assigns forever, To have and to hold occupy and enjoy the same thereof to him the said Aquilla Bradley his heirs & assigns forever to the only and behoof him the s^d Aquilla Bradley his heirs and assigns against him the said John White or his heirs and assigns against the Lawful or demand of any other person or persons whatsoever shall do and will warrant and defend in witness whereof the said John White have hereunto set &
