

And confirm unto the said Francis Baswell his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing sixty eight acres more or less situated in the district aforesaid on the branch of Mush Creek waters of Tyger River being part of a tract of land conveyed by Archibald Taylor to myself and runs as follows that into say Beginning on a post oak on the ridge on the South East side of Mush Creek Samuel Baswells corner thence South sixty eight and a half degrees west thirty one chains & fifty links to a red oak thence South nineteen degrees west twelve chains & fifty links to a white oak thence South Eighty two degrees East two & one chain to a stake thence North thirty five degrees East four chains to a post oak stump thence due East five chains to a stake by a small branch then down the meander of branch to a maple at the mouth of said branch thence North thirty five degrees west to the Beginning containing sixty eight acres more or less as aforesaid Together with all singular the Rights incidents and appurtenances to the premises before-mentioned or in any wise Incident or appertaining to them and to hold all and singular the premises afove mentioned unto the said Francis Baswell his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the afove mentioned premises unto the said Francis Baswell his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

 branch to a white oak corner upon said branch thence a conditional line upon the dividing Ridge to  
 a black oak & thence a conditional line binding upon such said Whitmires land to a white oak thence  
 binding upon Jeremiah Whitmires line to the beginning corner with all and singular the Rights inci-  
 dents incidents and appurtenances houses plantations belonging to the said premises I bind my-  
 self my heirs Executors administrators and assigns unto the said Peter Hitt his heirs Executors  
 administrators and assigns to have and to hold free from me myself my heirs Executors adm-  
 inistrators and assigns and do warrant and for ever defend the said premises free from me  
 myself and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as
