The premises together with all and singular the rights incidents and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the sd James Hooker his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exors and Adors to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the sd premises unto the said James Hooker his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
