 William D. Bradford of St. Clair County Alabama and Lemuel Brad
 = ford of Greenville District South Carolina our true and lawful
 Attornies for us and in our names to sell or dispose of the aforesaid tract of land
 absolutely in fee simple for such price or sum of money or to such person or per
 son as they may think fit or convenient and also for us and in our name &
 as our act and deed to sign seal Execute and deliver such deed and
 Conveyances for the absolute sale or disposal thereof or any part thereof with such
 clauses Covenants or agreements to be therein contained as our said attornies William
 D. Bradford and Lemuel J. Bradford Executors of the Estate of Philemon Br
 = adford deceased shall think fit and convenient hereby ratifying and
 confirming all such deeds Conveyances bargains and sales which shall at
 any time hereafter be made by our said attornies touching or confir
 = ming the premises &c Given under our hands and seals this the four
 = teenth day of September Anno Domini 1826.
