 dollars to me in hand paid by Jesse Roberts of said State and district aforesaid  
 have granted bargained and sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release  
 unto the said Jesse Roberts twenty acres of land more or less out of the tract left  
 me by my Father William Chandler Beginning on a white oak on the N. side  
 of the Sawpit branch on the said Jesse Roberts line thence Northerly to a post  
 oak on James H. Hooker's line thence with said line Northerly to a pine near the  
 road thence with said road w. only to Martin Ayres corner on a hickory thence  
 Southerly with the original to the Saw pit branch thence with the meander of  
 said Branch to the beginning Together with all & singular the rights members  
 Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 Incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises  
 before mentioned unto the said Jesse Roberts his heirs and assigns for ever  
 & I do hereby bind my self my heirs & Executors administrators to warrant and  
 defend the above mentioned premises from my self my heirs and Executors  
 & C. Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the thirty first day of Decem-  
 ber & in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty one signed  
 sealed and delivered in presence of Jas. H. Gilreath, James Hooker Joseph Chandler
