 red Oak thence S. 60. E. 11. ch. to a red oak thence S. 76 W. 32. ch. running
 with Pandey road to a Post oak and small chestnut by the roadside
 of the road thence N. 24. ch. to a small persimmon & pine knot
 thence N. 7. E. 14 ch. 50 lbs to a hickory near the fence of the plantation
 attached to the Estate of James Blasingame thence with the direction
 of the fence to the River thence with the meanders thereof to the be-
